My research focuses on embodied cognition and its philosophical and empirical ramifications, in particular in the field of neuroscience and psychiatry. I am currently working on a project on translation, which addresses the question of how to translate findings from fundamental neuroscientific research into psychiatric practice and vice-versa.
